Sophia Chandelier Installation Instructions

Important: Installation must be performed by a **licensed electrician**.

Read these instructions thoroughly before starting.

This fixture must be installed in accordance with all applicable codes by a qualified person familiar with low-voltage systems, lighting equipment, and associated hazards.

1 Pendant Approx 18 lbs / 3 Pendants Approx 55 lbs / 4 Pendants Approx 75 lbs

Two people are recommended for safe handling and installation.

Safety Precautions

- **Turn off power** at the circuit breaker before beginning any electrical work.
- Use appropriate lifting techniques or equipment to support the fixture during installation.
- Do **not** use a knife or sharp object to remove protective wrapping this may damage the finish or wiring.
- Follow all local building and electrical codes.
- Ensure all connections are secure and properly grounded.

Installation Overview

1. Unpack Components Carefully

- Remove the outer wrapping from the canopy without using a knife.
- Leave pendants wrapped until fully installed to prevent damage.
- Place a thick towel or foam pad (from shipping materials) under the pendant to protect it during installation.

2. Determine Fixture Orientation

- Identify the correct orientation of the pendant based on room layout.
- Make sure the holes in the steel mounting bracket align with your planned pendant direction.

3. Mount the Canopy

- Secure the steel canopy bracket to the ceiling according to applicable codes.
- Use hardware appropriate for the ceiling structure and weight of the fixture.

4. Attach Hanging Rods to Pendant

- Starting with the shortest pendant, fish the fixture wire up through the hanging rod.
- o Thread the rod onto the all-thread nipple at the top of the stirrup (on the pendant).
- Ensure the rod is tight and the pendant is secure.

5. Wire and Secure Pendants

- Pass the pendant wire through the appropriate hole in the canopy.
- Inside the canopy, secure the pendant using the lock washer and large brass knurled nut.
- o Route the wire to the **center of the canopy** for electrical connection.

6. Repeat for Remaining Pendants

- Continue with pendants from shortest to longest to ensure proper spacing and aesthetics.
- o Connect all pendant wires to the main electrical connection inside the canopy. Double-check connections and grounding.

7. Final Assembly

- o Carefully remove protective foam wrap from each pendant. **Do not use a knife.**
- Place the magnet on the crossbar and attach the inspection cap to complete the installation.
